

TEMPORARY EMERGENCY ORDER No. 2020-01

A Temporary Emergency Order extending the provisions of Chase County Commission Resolution 2020-09 relating to the on-going COVID-19 pandemic until 11:59 p.m. on August 31, 2020

I, Anthony Hazelton, the duly elected and acting Chairman of the Chase County Commission, acting pursuant to the powers vested in said office, do hereby extend the provisions of Chase County Resolution No. 2020-09 relating to an Emergency Declaration concerning the on-going COVID-19 pandemic from its scheduled expiration at 11:59 p.m. on the 26th day of August, 2020, until 11:59 p.m. on the 31st day of August, 2020.

On said 31st day of August, 2020, a regularly scheduled meeting of said Commission will convene at which time the body of the whole may determine whether to continue any Emergency Declaration, and, if so, define the precise terms thereof.


