If you tear, deface, or make a mistake and wrongfully mark any ballot, you must return it to the election board and receive a new ballot or set of ballots.

Making selections



To vote for a person or pair of candidates, darken the oval to the left of the person's name.

Optional write-in



To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the person's name on the line provided and darken the oval.

To vote for presidential electors for candidates for president and vice-president darken the oval at the left of the names of the candidates.
