RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 04

A Resolution Rescinding Resolution 2020-3

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of March, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Chase County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Chase County, Kansas, memorialized as Resolution 2020-3; and

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Chase County, Kansas; and




WHEREAS, the Legislature and the Governor of the State of Kansas have declared a state of public health emergency applicable statewide; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Governor's authority, the Governor will be providing for emergency orders relating to the mitigation of the effects of COVID-19 by Executive Order effective at 12:01 a.m. on May 4, 2020, which the Chase County Commission believes will be adequate to provide for the health and welfare of the residents of Chase County; and

WHEREAS, the Chase County Commission intends to carefully monitor the COVID -19 situation locally, and, if necessary, to again adopt a declaration of local public health emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Chase County, Kansas that, effective at 12:59 p. m. on May 3, 2020, Resolution 2020-3 relating to the state of local public health emergency in Chase County, Kansas declared on the 16th day of March. 2020, is hereby rescinded.
