## Resolution No. 2021-12

## A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF CHASE COUNTY, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the County of Chase County was calculated as 51.348 mills by the Chase County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the County of Chase County will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on September 13, 2021 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the County of Chase County, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF CHASE COUNTY:

The Board of Chase County Commissioners shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 51.348 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
