## RESOLUTION RESTRICTING VEHICLES TO POSTED BRIDGE WEIGHTS ON COUNTY ROADS

A Resolution Restricting Vehicles to Posted Bridge Weights

WHEREAS, in order to protect the integrity of Chase County bridges, and as provided by K.S.A. 8-1912, the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS believes that it is in the public interest to restrict vehicles to posted bridge weights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of County Commissioners of Chase County, Kansas, in regular session assembled in its Chambers at the seat of government thereof that the following traffic regulation is hereby established:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to violate a posted bridge weight by traversing any Chase County bridge when the vehicle exceeds the posted weight.

Section 2. Any violation hereof shall be a Class A Misdemeanor as defined by K.S.A. 21-6602(a)(1) and, in addition to any other lawful Sentence authorized by law, the Court shall impose a fine of \$2,500.00 per violation

Section 3. This is an ordinary home rule resolution and shall be effective upon publication once in the official County newspaper, and the prohibition and restrictions provided in this Resolution shall become effective upon publication.
