A Resolution establishing a KFAA fund (Fund No. 325)

WHEREAS, Chase County has received funds from the State of Kansas for the Kansas Fights Addiction Act (KFAA) to address the ongoing opioid addiction crisis, and funds are anticipated to be received from the State of Kansas to be expended in accordance with governing laws or regulation; and

WHEREAS, Chase County government requires the establishment of an accounting Fund to properly account for KFAA funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHASE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, in regular session assembled in the Courthouse of said County at the seat of government thereof, that there is hereby established Fund No. 325 to account for the collection and distribution of KFAA funds.
